Conclusion:

The proposed reorganisation could cost the Isle of Wight Council Tax Payer between £0.5m and £3m per annum.

If the Council is right to claim overall annual savings to be £1.5m then we calculate that the average spend per head will rise by a maximum of £82 per annum or 23p per day per child.

However, we dispute this figure, having calculated the raw savings, before transport costs are taken into account, to be far lower at £ 612,448, 41% or a little under half what the council claim. On this basis the increase in spend per head amounts to only £34 per child per annum or 9p per day before transport costs are accounted for.

However once transport costs are taken into account any saving may be completely wiped out. We have calculated that the cost of transporting years 7 and 8 from middle schools to the new secondary schools will cost between £2m and £3m depending on the price of fuel (source: Scottish Schools Network 2006). We have not calculated the cost of primary school transport in respect of the amalgamating and closing primary schools. Nor have we been able to calculate the numbers of children already being bussed to school. We do not believe that these will have a great impact on our analysis. None the less we have rounded our figures down to the nearest £million. These figures are therefore likely to be conservative.

It is worth bearing in mind that there have been no figures made available by the IWC despite requests at public meetings.
